# Rules & Guidelines

As an approved school trip/activity, all rules and policies set forth in the *Hickman High School Student Handbook* will be in effect for the duration of this trip.

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## GENERAL GUIDELINES

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- Remember, we are ALWAYS in the public's eye. You will not only be representing yourselves, but also Hickman High School, Columbia Public Schools, and the community of Columbia, Missouri.
  - Always exercise rules of good judgment. Never do anything in poor taste to discredit you, your parents, your peers, your directors, your school or your community.
- Always cooperate with Chaperones and Staff.
- Meet all time schedules and BE FLEXIBLE!
  - Remember, the itinerary is designed with the best interest of the GROUP in mind. Moving a large group takes longer than moving an individual. Be patient, listen and cooperate.
  - Review your itinerary and be aware of your responsibilities.
  - Understand that the intended itinerary will likely change from time-to-time. Again, be patient, listen and cooperate. [Just "go with it" and have fun!]

## DRUG AND ALCOHOL POLICY

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- NO DRUGS – NO ALCOHOL – NO TOBACCO OF ANY KIND.
  - Your safety, and the safety of others, is our primary concern. Therefore, the Hickman Band Program operates on a NO TOLERANCE Policy regarding the use of drugs, alcohol and tobacco. [*There are no "mistakes", only choices.*]
  - The band directors and/or chaperones reserve the right to inspect your luggage, carry-on bags, instrument cases, rooms, etc. if it is suspected that you may possess any of these items.
  - Anyone in possession of, or under the influence of, illegal substances will be dealt with immediately. Consequences may include any or all, but are not limited to, the following:
    1. Contact parents.
    2. Contact local law enforcement authorities.
    3. Ineligibility for future band activities, performances, or travel.
    4. Immediate return to Missouri at the parent's expense.



# Rules & Guidelines

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## DRESS CODE

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- General:
  - Casual wear is appropriate for the entire trip.
  - T-Shirts are acceptable as long as they do not advertise alcohol, drinking, drugs, tobacco, or display any inappropriate visual image or language.
  - Bring nice jeans/shorts [no holes].
  - *You will wear your trip t-shirt under your uniform on Friday and your HHS polo on Wednesday for your workshop.*
  - A good guideline to remember is: *If you have to ask, it is probably NOT appropriate!*
  
- In Orlando:
  - The weather in Orlando is generally very nice in November. As a general guideline, plan for 70-75 degrees during the day [shorts, t-shirts]. However, be sure to plan for a “back-up” in the event the temperature is too cool for shorts & t-shirts. Bring a light jacket; you may need it, especially in the evenings.
  - Remember to bring clothes that are appropriate for our beach time. Shorts, t-shirts, swimsuits, covers, sunglasses and hats are the normal attire.
  - Always use good judgment in the selection of your swimwear!  
*[Remember....If you have to ask, it is probably NOT appropriate!]*
  
- **Uniform:**
  - Make sure you have your full uniform.
    - COAT                      SHOES (cleaned!)
    - BIBS                      BLACK SOCKS
    - HAT                      GLOVES
    - GUANTLETS              TRIP SHIRT

## LUGGAGE RESTRICTIONS

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- All luggage and instruments should be clearly marked [on the outside] for quick and easy identification.
- All luggage and instruments must have a *Grueninger Music Tours* tag for group identification.
- Your luggage **MUST** be limited to the following:
  - **ONE SUITCASE** You will not be able to access this luggage until we reach the Hotel in Orlando on Tuesday evening.
  
  - **ONE CARRY-ON** [to remain with you on the bus]. A purse, backpack or small duffle bag is acceptable.





# Rules & Guidelines

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## MOTOR COACH TRAVEL

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- Dress Comfortably: this will be a *LONG* trip. Nice jeans or sweats are acceptable – you must look “presentable” when we stop along the way.
- No switching of buses at any time.
- Keep trash picked-up at all times.
- Always be respectful and courteous to the chaperones, bus drivers and tour directors.
- Never get-off the bus until told to do so by your directors, staff, chaperones, or tour director.
- Always use headphones when listening to ipods, phones, etc.
- Remain seated during the trip. **NO SLEEPING IN THE AISLE!!!**
- No coolers will be allowed.
- Keep all noise at a conversation level. [NO singing or yelling]
- Chaperones reserve the right to change bus assignments in the event of excessive public displays of affection, or for any behavior that is deemed inappropriate or disruptive.
- Do not leave personal items on the bus overnight.
- **DO NOT USE THE RESTROOMS ON THE BUS!!** When we stop use the restroom at every opportunity
- Quiet time will begin at 11:00 pm (or when designated by the chaperones) and will last until sunrise. Don't disturb others who are trying to sleep. Use every opportunity to rest – the fun really begins in Florida!!
- Please, no flash photography on the bus.
- **The buses are equipped with DVD players and wi-fi.**
  - **\*\*\*G, PG, PG13 RATED MOVIES ONLY!!!**
  - **\*\*** If you don't want to watch a movie that is being shown – sleep, listen to mp3, read a book, etc. (There is *plenty* of time for the movie you want to see)



# Travel Tips

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## WHILE IN THE PARKS AND AT THE BEACH

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- Always keep within a group of AT LEAST 4 people *from the Hickman tour*.
- Students will be required to periodically check-in with their designated chaperone throughout our time in the theme parks and at the beach. Each check-in will be in person.
- Boundaries will be established. Do not travel / swim outside the designated boundaries.

## HOTEL BEHAVIOR

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- Read the instructions [provided in your room] regarding escape procedures that need to be followed in the event of an emergency.
- In addition to our group, there will be many guests staying in the hotel. Be respectful to everyone! Always represent yourself, Hickman, and Columbia with class.
- Always be quiet and courteous while you are in and around the hotel.
  - Keep ALL noise to a minimum, at ALL times.
  - No congregating in the hallways or balconies.
  - Be quiet in the stairwells...they echo!
  - DO NOT play or practice instruments [practice pads] in your room.
- **NO GIRLS IN BOY'S ROOMS or BOYS IN GIRL'S ROOMS AT ANY TIME (Day or Night).**
- Curfew Guidelines:
  - Curfew times will be announced daily. At curfew, you must be in your own room. No one is to enter your room after this time except chaperones or staff. No exceptions
  - Students are not allowed out of their rooms after curfew, **for any reason.**
    - (Make calls); get ice/snacks BEFORE room check.
    - Do not order food after curfew. [You will not be allowed to go to the lobby to pick-up a pizza delivery, etc – and the chaperones won't get it for you.]
    - If you have an emergency, **call** your chaperone, Mr. Swope or Mr. Sweeney.
- Elevators are used to transport all hotel guests. When using the elevators, respect the fact that other guests are staying in the hotel.
- Telephones are available for proper use and are not to be used after curfew [except in an emergency].
  - Outside calls, long-distance or local, will be charged to your room and YOU will be responsible to settle the charges prior to departure.



## Travel Tips

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- Do not remove towels or other “souvenirs” from your room. You will be charged for any missing items.
- Do not damage the rooms. You will be held responsible for all costs resulting from any damage to your room or its contents.
- **DO NOT** drop or throw ANYTHING from the hotel balconies.
- Keep your room [including your balcony doors] locked at all times. [Know who has the key.]
- Safeguard your personal belongings.

## WHAT TO PACK

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- **NOTE REGARDING LUGGAGE:** Remember, one suitcase and one carry-on bag per person!
- **Toiletries:** It is recommended that you pack most toiletries [shampoo, razor, shaving cream, etc] in your suitcase. [Pack in a sealable plastic bag in case it leaks.]
- **Medication:** Any student that is taking prescription medication must notify their chaperone. Pack medications in your carry-on.
- **Camera and Film:** If your camera requires film, remember that film (and disposable cameras) will be cheaper to buy in Columbia than in Orlando.
- **Alarm Clock, Hair Dryer, Curling Iron, etc.:** Use the “Buddy System” – Check with your roommates and share so not everybody brings the same thing.
- **Swimsuit, Cover-Up, Beach Towel:** Towels may not be taken from the hotel to the beach. It is recommended to bring a towel from home. However it will take up space in your suitcase.
  - Consider taking a plastic bag for your swimsuit as it might be wet when you pack for home.
- **Jacket, Umbrella:** Bring a light jacket and a small umbrella as it does rain frequently in Florida.
- **Uniform, Trip Shirt, Hickman Polo, Marching Shoes & Black Tall Socks.**
- **Instruments, Reeds, Valve Oil, etc.**



# Travel Tips

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## SAFETY

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*Your safety, and the safety of others, is always a primary concern.  
Remember that this is the reason why we have rule and guidelines that govern our activities.*

- Always keep within a group of AT LEAST 4 people from the Hickman tour.
  - Never be totally alone.
  - Never let anyone be totally alone; invite them into your group.
- Always let someone know where you are / where you are going, and what you are doing.
- **Boundaries** will be established and **MUST** be observed.
  - Students will be required to periodically check-in with their designated chaperone.
  - Each check-in will be in person [not by cell phone].
- Students are not permitted to initiate or accept invitations from individuals that are not members of the Hickman Band or its chaperones.
- Be extremely cautious when engaging in conversation with strangers. If you are repeatedly bothered by someone, inform a chaperone, director, or law enforcement officer.
- NEVER offer personal information, or information pertaining to the group and its activities, (hotel, itinerary, etc.) to anyone you do not know.
- Keep track of your personal belongings.
  - Keep purse straps over your shoulder.
  - Keep your wallet in your front pocket.

## PUBLIC DISPLAYS OF AFFECTION

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- **P.D.A. is not acceptable at any time on the trip, including:**
  - **Travel on the bus.** Student will be separated and parents will be called.
  - **While in the parks.** Students will be asked to stay with chaperones and parents will be called.
  - **Hotel.** Student will be separated and parents will be called.



## Travel Tips

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### SPENDING MONEY

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- Meals – Refer to the itinerary to see which meals are provided for you.
  - Most people will feel that the Breakfast Buffet and the Dinner provided will be enough food for the day.
  - Two meals are provided for you each day with the exception of Monday and Sunday.
  - You should plan for snacks while traveling and during the lunch times.
- You will need money for any additional souvenirs, snacks, or emergency items that you wish to purchase.
  - Souvenir location possibilities:
    - Any of the Disney Parks
    - Kennedy Space Center
    - Ron Jon's Surf Shop
    - Disney Springs (Downtown Disney)
    - Universal Studios

### SUN & OCEAN

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- The Florida sun is a little more intense than the Missouri sun. Please use sunscreen liberally, and re-apply as necessary when exposed to the sun. Hats & Sunglasses are a must!
  - Remember, a severe sunburn will ruin your trip and can become a miserable experience.
- The ocean can be very dangerous! Swimmers should be aware that strong currents and undertows are possible at any time of year.
- **Beach Boundaries** will be established and **MUST** be observed.
  - Students will be required to periodically check-in with their designated chaperone.
  - Each check-in will be in person [not by cell phone].
- **NEVER SWIM ALONE!** If you are not a strong swimmer, be conservative when swimming in the ocean or in the pool.
